UPDATE FROM PUBLIC HOUSING DIRECTOR WHICH MAY INCLUDE OCCUPANCY RATES, WAIT LIST INFORMATION, UNIT MODIFICATIONS UPDATE AND UPCOMING TRAINING

The Public Housing Director provided information regarding Public Housing occupancy rates, which are currently at 96%, and provided an update regarding current modernization of two Public Housing units.

After stating that since the beginning of January, three new families have been housed in Public Housing units, the Public Housing Director reported that the Housing Choice Voucher program is currently at an 83% utilization rate, which is an increase of 12% since her last report. The Public Housing Director discussed the Housing Choice Voucher program and provided additional information regarding the Housing Choice Voucher/Section 8 program waiting list. The Public Housing Director also discussed the Emergency Housing Voucher program including continuing efforts with the Local Coalition to End Homelessness to assist families to obtain housing.

In conclusion, the Public Housing Director stated that staff continues to attend training and thanked her staff for their work in maintaining their units. The Public Housing Director also responded to questions from members of the Commission regarding the best way to get on the waitlist. Chairperson Cano suggested posting flyers at businesses as a way to get the information out to the public.
